

# DOMESTIC CARE AIDE

# 7 Week Course | April 21 – June 6, 2025

Saskatoon Trades & Skills Centre (STSC) is pleased to offer an seven (7) week Domestic Care Aide (DCA) course. The DCA course will give you the basic skills needed to gain employment in the health care field. You will work closely with Job coaches and certified instructors to help build your knowledge base and leave with the required certificates for the field. Students spend 4 weeks in-class and 3 weeks of on-the-job training with our community partners. As a domestic care aide, you will work to support the health and wellbeing of clients in residential care settings. You will support clients with personal care activities as well as daily home management tasks. You will gain the knowledge to assist in person-centered care as part of a healthcare team. (NOC 44101)

## **Requirements:**

- Proof of Vaccination for Covid-19 may be a requirement at some work placements.
- A minimum language level of CLB Level 6 in all four categories (reading, writing, listening, speaking)
  \*For applicants with English as a second language\* Must be a Permanent resident to apply.
- A Clear Criminal Record and Vulnerable Sector Check will be required for selected applicants. (Paid for by STSC)
- Must be willing to work evenings and weekends.
- A direct deposit form from your bank for the first day of class (if you are selected for the program).
   This means if you do not have a bank account, you must have a valid ID to open an account.

- The online application is the only way to apply for the course.
- Make sure to enter your correct email address all details regarding your application are sent by email.
