You must be able to attend an online orientation **August 25, 2025** and potential online interview that week

### Requirements:

- A minimum language level of **CLB Level 7 in all four categories** (reading, writing, listening, speaking)  
*\*For applicants with English as a second language\**
- *Must be a Canadian Citizen or Permanent Resident and residing in Saskatchewan for 6 months to apply.*
- Proof of **Grade 12** or equivalent is required.
- A Clear Criminal Record Check with vulnerable sector search will be required for selected applicants. (Paid for by STSC)
- A direct deposit form from your bank for the first day of class (if you are selected for the program). This means if you do not have a bank account, you must have valid ID to open an account.
