The Saskatoon Trades & Skills Centre (STSC) is pleased to offer a 13-week Early Childhood Education (ECE) Level I Course. The ECE Level I course is an accredited course through Sask Polytech and upon successful completion participants receive a certificate from the Ministry of Education. ECE Level I certification will allow individuals to work in any licensed daycare across Saskatchewan.

Participation in STSC programs requires individuals to be willing and able to work directly in the field upon completion of the program.

- Food Safety
- Mental Health First Aid
- Play and Exploration Workshop
- Workplace Essential Skills
- A Day in the Daycare

Requirements:

- A minimum language level of **CLB Level 7 in all four categories** (reading, writing, listening, speaking) **For applicants with English as a second language.**
- Canadian citizens, Permanent residents and/or individuals with a Valid Open Work Permit (check with IRCC regarding eligibility) can apply – must be residing in Canada for at least 6 months.
- Proof of **Grade 12** or equivalent is required.
- A Clear Criminal Record Check with vulnerable sector search will be required for selected applicants. (Paid for by STSC)
- A direct deposit form from your bank for the first day of class (if you are selected for the program). This means if you do not have a bank account, you must have valid ID to open an account.
