Saskatoon Trades & Skills Centre (STSC) is pleased to offer a 7-week Landscape Labourer course. This course will provide participants with the basic knowledge, practical skills, and certifications needed to gain employment as an entry level landscape labourer.

Landscaping and grounds maintenance labourers perform work to assist in the construction of landscapes and related structures, and to maintain lawns, gardens, athletic fields, golf courses, cemeteries, parks, landscaped interiors and other landscaped areas. NOC Code 8612

You must be able to attend an **online orientation March 16th** and potential online interview that week

Requirements:

- A minimum language level of **CLB Level 6 in all four categories** (reading, writing, listening, speaking) *For applicants with English as a second language* Canadian citizens, Permanent residents or individuals with a valid work permit (check with IRRC regarding eligibility) can apply – must be residing in Canada for at least 6 months.
- Must be willing to work evenings and weekends.
- A direct deposit form from your bank for the first day of class (if you are selected for the program). This means if you do not have a bank account, you must have a valid ID to open an account.
- **A valid Class 5 driver's license is an asset.**
- **A Clear Criminal Record** will be required for selected applicants. (Paid for by STSC)
