## Requirements:

- A minimum language level of **CLB Level 7 in all four categories** (reading, writing, listening, speaking) *\*For applicants with English as a second language\**
- *Must be a Canadian Citizen or Permanent Resident and residing in Saskatchewan for 6 months to apply.*
- Must be able to work evenings and weekends.
- Valid Class 5 Driver's license is preferred.
- A direct deposit form from your bank for the first day of class (if you are selected for the program). This means if you do not have a bank account, you must have a valid ID to open an account.
