#### **Requirements:**

- A minimum language level of <u>CLB Level 7</u> in all four categories (reading, writing, listening, speaking) \*For applicants with English as a second language\*
- Must be a Canadian Citizen or Permanent Resident and residing in Saskatchewan for 6 months to apply.
- Proof of Grade 12 or equivalent is required.
- A Clear Criminal Record Check with vulnerable sector search will be required for selected applicants. (Paid for by STSC)
- A laptop to access training is preferred but not required.
- A direct deposit form from your bank for the first day of class (if you are selected for the program). This means if you do not have a bank account, you must have valid ID to open an account.

- The online application is the <u>only</u> way to apply for the course
- Make sure to enter your correct email address all details regarding your application are sent by email
