## 13 Week Course | February 23rd - May 22nd, 2026

The ECE Level I course is an accredited course with Sask Polytech and upon completion students receive a certificate from the Ministry of Education. ECE Level I certification will allow individuals to work in any licensed daycare across Saskatchewan.

Applications close at 12:00 midnight on February 4, 2026

You must be able to attend an online orientation **February 9, 2026** and potential online interview that week

### **Requirements:**

- A minimum language level of <u>CLB Level 7</u> in all four categories (reading, writing, listening, speaking) \*For applicants with English as a second language.\* Canadian citizens, Permanent residents or individuals with a valid work permit (check with IRRC regarding eligibility) can apply must be residing in Saskatchewan for at least 6 months.
- Proof of Grade 12 or equivalent is required.
- A Clear Criminal Record Check with vulnerable sector search will be required for selected applicants.
   (Paid for by STSC)
- A direct deposit form from your bank for the first day of class (if you are selected for the program). This means if you do not have a bank account, you must have valid ID to open an account.
