The Saskatoon Trades & Skills Centre (STSC) is pleased to offer a 7-week Steel Stud & Drywall Labourer course. This course will provide participants with the basic knowledge, practical skills, and certifications needed to gain employment as an entry level labourer.

Program participants will learn various applications of metal framing used in commercial construction projects including layout and installation of drywall.

*Please Note: The program will be paused between December 22nd, 2025 and January 2nd, 2026 for the Holiday break. All programs resume on Monday, January 5th, 2026.

Requirements:

- A minimum language level of **CLB Level 6 in all four categories** (reading, writing, listening, speaking) **For applicants with English as a second language* Canadian citizens, Permanent residents or individuals with a valid work permit (check with IRRC regarding eligibility) can apply – must be residing in Saskatchewan for at least 6 months.*
- A direct deposit form from your bank for the first day of class (if you are selected for the program). This means if you do not have a bank account, you must have valid ID to open an account.
- Availability to work weekend and evening shifts may be required.
- **Valid Class 5 license an asset**
